Understanding Thermocoagulation for Skin Imperfections

Thermocoagulation is a precise, non-surgical technique that uses controlled heat energy delivered through a fine probe to treat superficial skin imperfections. At Cantik Esthetics, treatments are performed using the **Silhouet-Tone Vasculyse 2G RF**, a Health Canada regulated device, by a practitioner with extensive, specialized experience in precision skin correction.

1 HOW IT WORKS

A hair-fine sterile probe delivers a targeted burst of high-frequency heat to the surface of the lesion. This causes localized protein coagulation, sealing tiny blood vessels or dehydrating the targeted tissue without cutting, bleeding, or damaging the surrounding skin.

2 WHAT IT TREATS

Skin tags

Milia

Cherry angiomas

Brown spots

Keratosis

Fordyce spots

Cholesterol deposits

Small broken capillaries

3 THE TREATMENT JOURNEY

01

CONSULTATION

Skin assessment, medical history review, and a personalized plan. Sessions needed depend on lesion size, number, and type.

02

NUMBING (IF NEEDED)

Ice and topical numbing are applied if needed. Pain tolerance differs from person to person.

03

TREATMENT

A controlled radiofrequency (RF) current is delivered via the Silhouet-Tone Vasculyse 2G RF to precisely target the lesion. Discomfort varies from person to person.

04

AFTERCARE & FOLLOW-UP

Scab forms in 3–7 days — leave on, keep clean & dry. Full regeneration: 28–32 days. Larger lesions needing a second treatment: 4–6 weeks between sessions.

Appointments are **1-hour sessions** that include your consultation, numbing (if needed), treatment, and follow-up guidance.

4 WHO SHOULD WAIT OR AVOID

- **Pregnant or breastfeeding** clients
- **Active infection, cold sores, or sunburn** in the treatment area
- **Pacemakers or implanted electrical devices** without physician clearance
- **Keloid-prone skin** or a history of poor wound healing
- **Upcoming travel or a special occasion?** Start treatment well in advance, or wait until after — healing time depends on location (face/body) and removal size

5 AFTERCARE ESSENTIALS

DAY 1–3

Slight inflammation is normal.

SPF

Broad-spectrum SPF 30+ daily on treated area.

REGENERATION

Full cell regeneration: 28–32 days.

POST-TREATMENT CARE

Hale Derma soothing spray is available for purchase after your session to help accelerate healing.

DAY 3–5

Scab forms — leave in place, keep clean & dry.

AVOID

Picking the scab, saunas, direct sun.

HEALING

Wound healing time differs per client.
